

Day 1: HomeTown – NYC (Thur, 12/23) Welcome to the Big Apple! Upon arrival, you will be met at the baggage claim area of your selected airline by our professional tour guide, and then be escorted to the hotel on our scheduled huttle bus for rest.

Day 2: NYC-Philadelphia-Washington D.C. (Fri, 12/24)

Visit the birthplace of this great nation in the morning: Independence Hall & Liberty Bell in the Independence Park, which has been ranked as the most historic square mile in this country. Move on to today's most influential political center in the world – Washington D.C. Besides the White House, Capitol Hill, popular museums, Jefferson Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Vietnam and Korean War Memorials, you are invited to take our exclusive cruise on Potomac River to explore some best kept secrets!

Day 3: Washington-Corning-Niagara Falls (Sat, 12/25)

Passing by Harrisburg, the Capital of Pennsylvania State, arrive in the sweetest town on our Planet -- Hershey. DAY 4: Niagara Falls - Boston (Sun, 12/26)

We will continue the next day with tours of Niagara Falls, including a visit to IMAX Niagara Falls. DAY 5: Boston-Rhode Island-Boston (Mon, 12/27)

DAY 7: New York City Tours (Full Day) (Wed, 12/29)

We start off our tour in New York City by heading to Ground Zero, site of the tragic events of September 11th. We head to Wall Street at the heart of the financial district. The tour proceeds to Chinatown and take in a Waterway cruise of the New York City harbor, where you can view the city's magnificent skyline, including the South Street Seaport, the Statute of Liberty, and the Brooklyn Bridge from the Hudson and East River. An entertaining and informative tour guide will provide interesting facts about all of the sights that make this city special. We will visit Rockefeller Center, NBC Studios, and the surrounding shopping district along Fifth Avenue, where cutting edge fashion and luxury brands reside. We will stop at the Empire State Building, 1,050 feet above the city's bustling streets, the Observatory offers panoramic views from within a glass enclosed pavilion. We will also see the newly transformed USS Intrepid Sea-Air-Space Museum. The tour continues to the bright lights of Time Square and the Broadway Theatre District. We will visit the United Nations and spend time in the Metropolitan Museum of Arts.
